ROBIN

Based on the artwork in a 1920s Robin Starch advert. It can be worked in outline or filled in with blocks of colour. Choose any thread you like to work with – stranded cotton, perle cotton, coton a broder, silk – just bear in mind that the smaller of the two designs will look better in a thinner thread than the larger model.

The stitched model on the website was worked using the smaller of the two transfers, and 2 strands of Splendor silk throughout. All the lines were worked in stem stitch, and the eye was done in round Rhodes stitch.

Eye, beak & legs: 801 black note: use 1 strand to do the legs in outline, or 2 to work them as a single line each

Body: blended 853 dk brown / 959 med brown

Tail: 853 dk brown

Breast: blended 822 dk red / 821 med red Twig: blended 959 med brown / 928 lt brown

Leaves: one half of each leaf blended 958 dk green / 906 med green, other half

blended 906 med green / 905 lt green
